**Do your duty and Make a difference... Vote May 6th!**

In Indiana in 2002, control of the House of Representatives was decided by a single house seat in Marion and Hamilton Counties where the winner won by only 37 votes!

In 1876, with the Presidential election thrown into the House, Rutherford B. Hayes won by a single vote, cast by an Indiana Congressman who himself had been elected by a one vote margin. That same year, a one vote margin brought Texas into the Union. So in effect, one Hoosier voter was responsible for Texas becoming a state and deciding who would become our next President.

### **New Voting Requirement:**

A new Indiana law requires every voter to present a photo I.D. According to the Indiana Secretary of State's Office "In most cases, an Indiana driver's license, Indiana photo I.D. card, U.S. Passport, or Military I.D. is sufficient."
